## **CONGRESS PRESENTATION**

The Medical Informatics Europe (MIE) congress is the main scientific event in medical informatics to be held every two years out of three in Europe. Its attendance amounts up to 1000 participants from 26 European member countries of the European Federation for Medical Informatics (EFMI). Several scientists from other parts of the world regularly attend this event

Expected scientific contributions to the congress are welcome from any countries all over the world. The Scientific Program Committee (SPC) and a panel of international experts will review the contributions. The proceedings of the conference are indexed in MEDLINE.

Thematic tracks with selected papers and posters:

- sharing resources between bio-informatics and medical informatics: sharing knowledge, common data and tools, interactions and potentialisation for the benefit of patients;
- image processing and feature extraction;
- electronic health records and information systems;
- biosignal analysis, human interface, quality assessment, patients as citizens, statistical methods, knowledge engineering, telematics, etc.

The main theme of 2005 is the development of connections between bio-informatics and medical informatics. Tools and concepts from both disciplines can potentiate each other. Information derived at the molecular level influences patient care processes. New bridges must be built.

For this purpose, a panel of high level scientists will be invited to participate and to give keynote speeches, tutorials and workshop discussions.

## **CALL FOR PAPERS**

#### Contributions are:

- Papers: original scientific articles, up to 6 pages, peer reviewed by a college of international experts, relating recent work or opinion of the authors, published in the conference paper proceedings IOS Press and the conference CD-ROM, indexed in Medline.
- Submitted papers will be classified by the Scientific Program Committee in long papers (20 minutes presentation), short papers plus poster (5 minutes presentations) and poster only presentations. All accepted contributions will be published on the conference CD-rom.
- Posters may be printed by the conference organizer on demand. See the mandatory format for electronic submission on the conference website.
- Workshops: thematic debates and presentations under the leadership of EFMI working groups or established entities.
- Demonstrations: provision for theatre-style demonstration of applications.
- Tutorials: addressed to a selected audience, half or full day.
